## 2 Rigorous Assessment Content

- Assessments include technology-enhanced item types
  - ▶ Equation Response—Student *solves* and *enters* formulaic answers
  - ▶ Edit Task Choice and Inline—Student *executes* corrections in text
  - ▶ Evidenced Based—Student *justifies* their response to the question
  - ▶ Grid/Hot Spot—Student *labels* diagrams or *arranges* content in a display
  - ▶ Grid/Plotting—Student *draws* geometric responses
  - ▶ Matching—Student *makes* combinations to represent correct responses
  - ▶ Multi-Select—Student *considers* details of items with more than one potential answer
  - ▶ Simulation—Student *makes decisions* about variables and *observes* results to *make conclusions*
- Writing essay items with automatic scoring using artificial intelligence
  - ▶ High depth of knowledge (DOK) standards can be assessed
  - ▶ Immediate scores available saving time for teachers and giving timely feedback to students
  - ▶ Flexibility to rescore essays as needed
  - ▶ Students practice writing simulating their summative assessment
- *ClearSight* items are aligned to grade-level standards by trained assessment experts

### 3 Assessments and Authoring All in One

- *ClearSight* has benchmark and interim assessments that are ready to use
  - ▶ Benchmark: Fixed-forms focusing on a reporting category and can be used in accordance with curriculum planning
