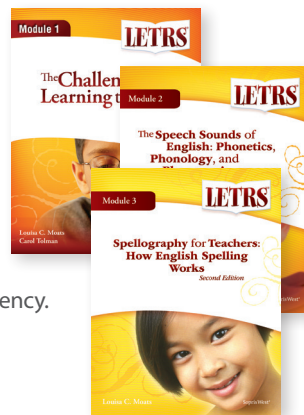
Become a LETRS® Trainer to support your district in building a sustainable model in the use of LETRS professional development for years to come.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

The LETRS Trainer is an individual with a deep understanding of the content and a commitment to become an expert in the research and evidence-based theories of LETRS. This individual will facilitate face-to-face workshops aligned to each module, facilitate Professional Learning Communities, and answer questions from participants to ensure understanding is solid. Review participants' online data to determine if gaps in conceptual understanding exist that need to be addressed in a customized workshop.

Attendees at this session must meet eligibility requirements listed below. Space is limited to 25 participants.

1. Participate in an initial training for Modules 1-3.
2. Purchase a Presenter's Kit.
3. Successfully pass the post-Modules 1-3 exam.
4. Sign a Statement of Commitment with Voyager Sopris.
5. Complete a minimum of eight sessions of ongoing professional development offered by Voyager Sopris annually. Requires license to the Literacy Symposium.
6. Remain employed or contracted by the sponsoring agency.



HOW IS THE TRAINING ORGANIZED?

Trainer candidates will learn how to:

1. Use the Presenter's Guide and other resources to facilitate face-to-face sessions, PLCs, and group meetings when supporting teachers as they progress through each Module
2. Determine and communicate an implementation model and schedule for LETRS participants
3. Provide ongoing support to participants using suggested resources and tools

Participants should bring the LETRS Modules 1-3 books. Attendees will be issued the LETRS Presenter's Kit for Modules 1-3 that includes presentation notes, agendas, and access to digital files and other resources.
