

#### WHAT IS THE LANGUAGE! CURRICULUM?

LANGUAGE! is an intensive intervention for students in grades 3–12 who are substantially below grade-level expectations for literacy. With an explicit, systematic approach that is proven to accelerate the growth of striving readers and nonreaders, LANGUAGE! integrates instruction across key literacy strands—foundational skills, writing, vocabulary, fluency, grammar, comprehension, and spoken English.

#### SCIENCE OF READING

Based on the science of reading and Structured Literacy, *LANGUAGE!* guides teachers and students through a scaffolded, explicit, systematic, and cumulative approach to learning.

- Phonemic awareness and phonics are taught by the teacher and help students learn the building blocks of language.
- Spelling rules and sound-to-letter correspondences are taught explicitly by the teacher.
- Engaging lessons includes learning word roots/ origins with focus on pronunciation and contentbased language to develop the meaning of words.
- Concepts are taught in a concrete manner by taking abstract grammatical terms and using "key questions" to discover parts of speech and to better understand how words function in sentences.



- Fluency development is built into every lesson with multiple opportunities to assess progress.
   Students chart fluency progress for words, phrases, and passages as they move through the curriculum.

What do lessons look like?



- This consistent structure allows you and your students to begin to anticipate what's coming next.
- Writing is embedded in the lesson
  - Moving students from sentence to paragraph to multiparagraph writing
  - Provides instruction on how to respond to prompts that support grade-level and content-area writing
  - Variety of genre exposures such as narrative, persuasive, expository, and literary analysis





#### SIX STEPS FROM SOUND TO TEXT

LANGUAGE! takes students from oral fluency to sound to text in every lesson. These six steps provide the Scope and Sequence for the structure of LANGUAGE!

Students complete every step, every day making this an instructional design that answers the essential questions of what makes for good instruction:

- The Why—Helps teachers understand why they are teaching and lets students understand more of why they are learning the skills
- The What—Helps teachers understand what they are teaching and helps students understand what they are learning
- The How—How to adjust, how to differentiate, slow down, accelerate for individual students

#### INDIVIDUALIZED INSTRUCTION

#### **GRADE-LEVEL READING AND CONTENT**

LANGUAGE! contains a variety of genres and highly engaging texts which increase in difficulty within a unit. These texts are the key to accelerating reading achievement and comprehension by simultaneously filling in gaps in skills and exposing students to grade-level content and vocabulary.

- Decodable Text is text on the student's reading level
  - Phonics skills application
  - Builds fluency and practice decoding
  - Preteaches vocabulary and content
- Instructional Text is text used along with teacher guidance
  - Builds vocabulary and comprehension
  - Has a variety of text structures
  - Basis for writing in Step 6
- Challenging Text is text used for listening comprehension
  - Teacher uses as whole-group read-aloud
  - Expands knowledge, vocabulary, and comprehension
  - Exposure to a variety of literary genres and higher-order thinking skills

#### **DIFFERENTIATED**

Embedded within lessons is support for the teacher for enhancing and differentiating the learning experience.

- Customized teaching materials for students who need extra practice and reteaching
- Lesson focus and activities for linguistically diverse students
- Planning and pacing options for students who are ready to move on

#### LESSON PLANNING AND PACING

LANGUAGE! can be adjusted to fit into many different schedules. Lessons should be taught strategically but if time is limited can be distributed across several days.

- Flexible and will fit into many different schedule types
- 45-120 minutes of instruction time should be allotted
- With pacing of 90 minutes per day, teachers and students should finish two books within one school year

## EMBEDDED INSTRUCTION AND SUPPORT FOR ENGLISH LEARNERS

LANGUAGE! was designed to support all learners in the development of the English language. However, the following additions and programs are targeted to the specific needs of students who are at the beginning of their English language journey.

#### Focus on English Learning

This program offers quick lessons leading into the regular *LANGUAGE!* program that focuses on critical English language learning. Scaffolded to meet the needs of students, Speaking and Listening lessons are taught prior to each *LANGUAGE!* lesson in books A-C and are intended to provide an interactive lesson to introduce vocabulary.

This is known as "Step 0" and includes:

- Frontloading lesson vocabulary
- Developing academic and base vocabulary
- Reviewing important grammatical points
- Providing practice in oral fluency skills


#### **Everyday English PLUS**

Prepares English learners for entry into the LANGUAGE! program, is a full course and a standalone English language development program that is designed for students who are newcomers or students who have no English—very little English. This product can be bundled with Focus on English Learning and provides a solid foundation for success.

- Nine units of study

#### **Assessments**



LANGUAGE! provides a variety of assessments including placements, baseline assessments, ongoing, end-of-unit assessments and more.

#### **PLACEMENT**

Data from the *LANGUAGE!* Reading Scale Placement Test indicates which of three entry points are appropriate for each student.

#### Entry points:

- Book A
  - Students with poor decoding skills
  - Students still glued to print
  - Students with reading comprehension at a pre-primer level-grade 2.5
- Book C
  - Students with basic decoding skills
  - Students with a lack of advanced wordanalysis skills
  - Students with reading comprehension at grades 3.0-5.0
- Book E
  - Students who are in grades 7–12
  - Students who are proficient in soundsymbol correspondence and higher word analysis skills
  - Students who are reading 2+ years below grade level

#### **BASELINE ASSESSMENT**

Administered only once after a student's placement and prior to entering the LANGUAGE! curriculum. Scores on baseline tests constitute the starting point for measuring a student's progress through the curriculum.

#### **ONGOING ASSESSMENT**

The regular testing of student mastery of the content, concepts, and skills taught in the curriculum and ensures teachers have current information about each student to adjust pacing or provide instructional support activities for individual students.

#### SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT

At the end of each book and assesses critical skills of literacy.

#### DASHBOARD: ASSESSMENT SYSTEM (VPORT)

An easy-to-use database that allows teachers and administrators to record, track, and report student test results. Teachers and administrators can monitor student growth through reports that can be generated at the individual, class, building, and district levels.
